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## Is your world too small?

#### John 1:1-14

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.<sup>2</sup> He was with God in the beginning.

Jesus is creator.

<sup>3</sup> Through him all things were made; without him nothing was made that has been made.

Jesus is life.

Jesus is God.

<sup>4</sup> In him was life, and that life was the light of all mankind. <sup>5</sup> The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it.

John is a witness.

<sup>6</sup> There was a man sent from God whose name was John. <sup>7</sup> He came as a witness to testify concerning that light, so that through him all might believe. <sup>8</sup> He himself was not the light; he came only as a witness to the light.

t that gives light to Jesus is <u>light</u>.

<sup>9</sup>The true light that gives light to everyone was coming into the world.

Jesus is rejected.

<sup>10</sup> He was in the world, and though the world was made through him, the world did not recognize him. <sup>11</sup> He came to that which was his own, but his own did not receive him.

Jesus <u>saves</u>.

<sup>12</sup> Yet to all who did receive him, to those who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God— <sup>13</sup> children born not of natural descent, nor of human decision or a husband's will, but born of God.

Jesus adopts.

<sup>14</sup> The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us. We have seen his glory, the glory of the one and only Son, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth.

Jesus stepped into our bubble so we could experience grace and truth.

# When we intentionally step out of our bubble, Jesus takes us through a beautiful process:

A new experience

which leads us to...

A new <u>love</u> for the Jesus who stepped out heaven into our world
