Who are we serving?

Families who live within the Bellingham city limits and need some extra groceries.

Who is helping connect us to their needs?

Bellingham Food Bank works to make high quality and health food available to anyone who needs it. Our motto is "HUNGER IS UNACCEPTABLE." We believe in serving people with respect and dignity.

We receive thousands of pounds of donated food from our wonderfully supportive community and we rely on more than 200 regular weekly volunteers to pick up, sort and distribute food.

How are we serving?

Help us get healthy food to those who need it. While weekly volunteers form the backbone of our efforts, we also need groups to come in and help us sort our growing stacks of non-perishable donations. That's where your small group comes in!

BFB can host groups of 5-15 at the downtown location (1824 Ellis Street) spacious upstairs warehouse. A time commitment of 2-5 hours is required. We will provide a tour of the facility to better acquaint you with our important work and mission. Children 7 years old and up are welcome; however, adult to child ratio is important. Please bring gloves, water and a snack (if desired). Volunteers must wear close-toed shoes and it's recommended they be supportive and comfortable.

Available times include days Mon/Tues/Wed/Thurs/Fri and evenings Mon/Wed/ Fri. Weekends are possible too.
