

Part 1: What Does Jesus Pray for Me? Grant Fishbook, Teaching Pastor February 7 & 8, 2015

What is Jesus doing right now?

Praying for me.

Who then is the one who condemns? No one. Christ Jesus who died—more than that, who was raised to life—is at the right hand of God and is also interceding for us. - Romans 8:34

What did Jesus pray for us when he was here?

¹³ "I am coming to you now, but I say these things while I am still in the world, so that they may have the full measure of my joy within them. ¹⁴ I have given them your word and the world has hated them, for they are not of the world any more than I am of the world. ¹⁵ My prayer is not that you take them out of the world but that you protect them from the evil one. ¹⁶ They are not of the world, even as I am not of it. ¹⁷ Sanctify them by the truth; your word is truth. ¹⁸ As you sent me into the world, I have sent them into the world.

- John 17:13-18

A Common Summary of John 17:15

As followers of Jesus, we are to be in the world but not of the world.

4 Responses to Jesus' Prayer

Choice #1: I will not be of this God-forsaken world but I will not be in it either.

What do we do with Matthew 5:13, Matthew 5:14, and 1 Peter 2:12?

Choice #2: I will be <u>in</u> the world... <u>all the way in</u>
What do we do with 1 John 2:15-17, Romans 12:2, and John 15:19?

Choice #3: I will do nothing.

What do we do with 2 Timothy 4:3-4?

Choice #4: I will believe what Jesus truly prayed for us.

13 "I am coming to you now, but I say these things while I am still in the world, so that they may have the full measure of my joy within them. 14 I have given them your word and the world has hated them, for they are not of the world any more than I am of the world. 15 My prayer is not that you take them out of the world but that you protect them from the evil one. ¹⁶ They are not of the world, even as I am not of it. ¹⁷ Sanctify them by the truth; your word is truth. 18 As you sent me into the world, I have sent them into the world. - John 17:13-18

Jesus prayed:

Don't remove them; release them! (vs. 15a)

Don't placate them; protect them! (vs. 15b)

This is not their home (vs. 16)

Set them apart as they live out the living Word of God (vs. 17)

They are not of the world, but are most certainly sent into it (vs. 18)
