Cascade Connections - Cleaning/Kitchen Supply Bucket

Who are we serving?

Individuals with developmental disabilities in Whatcom County.

Who is helping connect us to their needs?

Cascade Connections provides services to individuals with developmental disabilities in our community through residential and vocational programs. Cascade Connections helps people gain the tools and knowledge to promote independent living and employment opportunities, and helps community members get to know the great people that Cascade Connections support and what they have to offer.

How are we serving?

Many clients in Cascade Connections' residential programs are low income and sometimes struggle with finding the finances for basic household supplies. A group is needed to gather materials and put together about 10-15 buckets of cleaning supplies, each one containing:

- Gloves (Latex-free, powder free)
- Lysol Spray
- Disinfectant Wipes
- Butterfly mop
- 2.5 gallon bucket
- Clorox toilet bowl cleaner
- Kitchen Towels

- Window cleaner
- Cleaning rags/reusable cleaing clothes,
- Toilet Brush and caddy
- Broom with dust pan
- Sponges
