At Fostering Together, we strive to increase the number of foster families across Western Washington, help families with the licensing process, and provide ongoing support to ensure their success. They also provide free, ongoing support in a variety of ways to families caring for foster children.
How are we serving?
Guide kids through a night of fun and entertainment for foster kids (and their fostering siblings) while parents who foster or have adopted enjoy and evening out to nurture their relationships and recharge their batteries. Volunteers will have the opportunity to lead a group of kids through fun activity stations, snacks and a movie night. Each station will be hosted by other volunteers who know the plan and can help make your night a success. A intervention team will even be there to help incase emotions run high. Your group can have an incredible time while creating an atmosphere of fun for kids who are navigating traumatic life circumstances. Things will be well planned and communication is sent out in advance so you will know what to expect.
