The Words of Proverbs 27:6

New International Version (NIV)

Wounds from a friend can be trusted,
but an enemy multiplies kisses.

New Living Translation (NLT)

Wounds from a sincere friend
are better than many kisses from an enemy.

English Standard Version (ESV)

Faithful are the wounds of a friend;
profuse are the kisses of an enemy.

Why do we avoid truth telling?

Because we are cowards and there is a cost.

The Truth-telling of Jesus

³⁸ As Jesus and his disciples were on their way, he came to a village where a woman named Martha opened her home to him. ³⁹ She had a sister called Mary, who sat at the Lord's feet listening to what he said. ⁴⁰ But Martha was distracted by all the preparations that had to be made. She came to him and asked, "Lord, don't you care that my sister has left me to do the work by myself? Tell her to help me!"

⁴¹ "Martha, Martha," the Lord answered, "you are worried and upset about many things, ⁴² but few things are needed—or indeed only one. Mary has chosen what is better, and it will not be taken away from her." – Luke 10:38-42

"Woe to you, teachers of the law and Pharisees, you hypocrites! You travel over land and sea to win a single convert, and when you have succeeded, you make them twice as much a child of hell as you are. – Matthew 23:15
