#### The Highs and Lows of Human Relationship

<sup>9</sup> Do your best to come to me quickly, <sup>10</sup> for Demas, because he loved this world, has deserted me and has gone to Thessalonica. Crescens has gone to Galatia, and Titus to Dalmatia. <sup>11</sup> Only Luke is with me. Get Mark and bring him with you, because he is helpful to me in my ministry. <sup>12</sup> I sent Tychicus to Ephesus. <sup>13</sup> When you come, bring the cloak that I left with Carpus at Troas, and my scrolls, especially the parchments.

And I was delivered from the lion's mouth. <sup>18</sup> The Lord will rescue me from every evil attack and will bring me safely to his heavenly kingdom. To him be glory for ever and ever. Amen.

<sup>19</sup> Greet Priscilla and Aquila and the household of Onesiphorus. <sup>20</sup> Erastus stayed in Corinth, and I left Trophimus sick in Miletus. <sup>21</sup> Do your best to get here before winter. Eubulus greets you, and so do Pudens, Linus, Claudia and all the brothers and sisters.

### Who is your Alexander? \_

God says... Do not repay evil for evil... Do not take revenge... "I will repay," says the Lord... Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good. - Romans 12:17-21

## The <u>Abandoned</u> Relationship

## Who has deserted you? \_

God says... "The Lord himself goes before you and will be with you; he will never leave you nor forsake you. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged." – Deuteronomy 31:8

# The <u>Reconciled</u> Relationship

Get Mark and bring him with you, because he is helpful to me in my ministry. (verse 11b)

### Who is your (John) Mark? \_\_\_\_\_

God says... "If your brother or sister sins, go and point out their fault, just between the two of you. If they listen to you, you have won them over. – Matthew 18:15

# The Faithful <u>Human</u> Relationship

Only Luke is with me. (verse 11a)

### Who is your Luke? \_\_\_\_\_

Have you neglected the faithful while fixating on the enemies?

Who are your Crescens, Titus, Luke, Tychicus, Priscilla, Aquila, Onesiphorus, Erastus, Trophimas, Ebulus, Pudens, Linus, and Claudia?

# The Faithful Divine Relationship

But the Lord stood at my side and gave me strength, so that through me the message might be fully proclaimed. (verse 17)

### Who stands with you and gives you spiritual strength? \_\_\_\_\_

Paul says... And I was delivered from the lion's mouth. The Lord will rescue me from every evil attack and will bring me safely to his heavenly kingdom. To him be glory for ever and ever. Amen. (verse 17-18)

God says... One who has unreliable friends soon comes to ruin, but there is a friend who sticks closer than a brother. - Proverbs 18:24
