John 9:1-7

- Why do you think the disciples asked the question regarding the blind man?
- What was the broader lesson Jesus was teaching them by His response?
- Why did Jesus heal him the way he did? How important is obedience in this miracle? How do you relate with the man regarding your trust in God?

John 9:16-18

- How did the Pharisees react to Jesus healing the man? What concerned them more than Jesus actually healing him?
- How can rule keeping get in the way of helping others?

John 9:24-25

- What do you think was the motive of the religious leaders in questioning the formerly blind man again?
- What was so powerful about the man's simple response?
- How is that an example to us of pure, simple faith in Jesus?

John 9:35-38

- Why did Jesus ask this question of the formerly blind man when he reconnected with him? What was the response of the man?
- What was the religious leaders' response to what Jesus said about who is truly blind?
- What causes spiritual blindness and how do we overcome it?
