Theme: *But, What I do Have I Give*

Warm Up: When was someone generous to you when you needed it the most?

Sermon Response: What was a “take-away” you received from Sunday’s message?

Read: Acts 3:1-10

- What do you think was going through the mind and heart of that crippled beggar on the day Luke writes about?
- Peter made it clear what he didn’t have and what he did have. How does that apply to how you help meet the needs of others in your life?
- Why do you think Peter had the confidence to pull this crippled man to His feet?
- How do we acquire such confidence in our lives, and how are we to use it today?
- What was significant about Peter invoking the name of Jesus for this man to walk?

- What was the response of the healed man, and how did this affect those around him?
- What was the greater purpose of this miracle performed by the apostles (the first miracle recorded after Jesus’ ascent)?
- Does God still do miracles today? If so, in what way are you hoping for a miracle, that you want prayer for?
