Summary of Duties

To grow and sustain a children's ministry culture of discipleship and leadership development. To effectively resource and empower parents in the spiritual development of their children with the partnership and support of the Kid's Place team.

Essential Functions

- Identify, train, and support Kids Place volunteers.
 - o Plan meetings, gatherings, and events to build team connection and focus.
- Assess and ensure child safety in coordination with other North Bay staff and teams.
- Direct Kids Place programming, curriculum, and budget.
- Coordinate volunteer schedule and Kid's Place calendar.
- Oversee Kids Place Check-In team.
- Oversee the check-out system and follow up with new families.
- Strategically collaborate with other ministries areas such as:
 - Students/Young Adults, Adult Small Groups, Other CTK Kids Ministry Leadership, etc.
- Attend monthly staff meeting.
- Meet weekly or bi-weekly with Discipleship Pastor.
