# Childcare for Caregiver Core Training (CCT)

#### Who are we serving?

Families who are attending the 8-session class necessary to become a foster parent. It is hugely beneficial for both parents to attend this class. To make that possible, we like to invite groups of volunteers to provide childcare for these families at Perch & Play.

### Who is helping connect us to their needs?

Skookum Kids is a foster care focused charity in Bellingham. We believe the world is full of people who want to help but don't know how. Our mission is to help people like that (maybe like you!) find a way to participate in foster care that is a good match for their gifts and season of life.

#### How are we serving?

We offer CCT 4 times each year. The dates in 2018 are:

Jan 29-Feb 1 & Feb 12-Feb 15 May 21-24 & June 4-7 August 20-23 & Sept 3-6 October 29-Nov 1 & Nov 12-15

Drop-off begins at 5:30p and class finishes at 9p, so you can expect to be finished around 9:30p.

4-6 adults can cover a single evening of childcare, so larger groups may want to take on a whole week and subdivide their group across multiple evenings.
