Doubt / John 20:24-29

Warm-up: Share about a time when something or someone came through in a moment when you didn't expect it?

Read: John 20:24-29

In this scene, we see Jesus directly respond to Thomas' doubt of His resurrection.

1. Thomas is the one disciple who voiced his doubt, but we know that other disciples doubted Jesus as well (see Matthew 28:16). How can you relate to Thomas' doubt of Jesus' resurrection?
2. What do you notice about the way in which Jesus addresses Thomas' doubt? What strikes you about how Jesus responds?
3. Jesus responds eight days after Thomas expresses his doubt. Why do you suppose God waits at times to respond to our doubt?
4. After Jesus reveals himself, Thomas worships him saying, "My Lord and my God!" What is significant to you about Thomas' response?
5. What doubts have you faced about God - either in the past or currently?
6. Has there been times where God has clearly revealed himself to you? What did that look like?
7. Look at verse 29. Does that comfort or challenge you in your faith journey?
8. What other questions do you have about this passage?
