
Small Group Conversation Guide

Warm-up: Let's start with a classic icebreaker question. If you could have any superpower, what would it be and why? Also, for fun, what would your superhero nickname be?

This Week's Message / Matthew 21:18-22

Two Big Questions (taken from PROAPT):

What is it saying about God?

What is it saying about me? Who? How? Why?

1. Here we have an upset Jesus cursing a fig tree and it dies. On the surface, it seems petty. *But what do you think Jesus was trying to teach his disciples through this demonstration of his power?*
2. What does Jesus say his disciples need to have in order to receive from God? Why do you think Jesus asks this of His disciples?
3. How would you describe your own journey through doubt and faith in God's power?
4. How have you seen God's power at work in your own life? (maybe most recently?)
5. Jesus basically tells his disciples to pray for everything they need. This seems simple, yet it can be a struggle to live out. Why do you think this is?
6. How have you seen God answer a prayer for you?
7. Does this passage comfort or challenge you?

Prayer: Let's live it out. How can we pray for God to be at work in your life?

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
